Mr. Harris,

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 32.3, *Amicus Curiae* the American Civil Rights Union respectfully requests permission to lodge with the Clerk, for consideration by the Court, copies of thirteen voter registration forms from Harris County, Texas. In its brief, the American Civil Rights Union references these documents as "Exhibit A" and indicated that it would request that the documents be lodged with the Clerk. *See* Brief for the American Civil Rights Union as *Amicus Curiae* in Support of Petitioners at 11 n.4.

The voter registration forms contained in Exhibit A relate to the citizenship verification measures on the Federal Voter Registration Form, the efficacy of which is at issue in Petitioners' Petition for Writ of Certiorari.
